In order to assess the application and compliance with these Guidelines, ESMA's BoS agreed in the 2017 Supervisory Convergence Work Programme3that a peer review on the Guidelines would be launched, with a possible focus on EPM techniques. This peer review was launched in September 2017, identifying six NCAs to be assessed by the AG.

Giving your overall opinion and general observations of the article is essential. Your comments should be courteous and constructive, and should not include any ad hominem remarks or personal details including your name (unless the journal you are invited to review for employs open peer review). Providing insight into any deficiencies is important.

**How to review - Elsevier**

The basic premise of peer review is to encourage further writing. The manuscript is a draft that the author seeks helpful feedback on, thus requiring a fair appraisal. Frame your criticism positively, empower the author to improve their writing and develop ideas. Give the good news along with the bad news.
